Family of the month is the **Jeff Knievel Family** for helping move snow for the elderly and shut-in folks of parish. Thank You!



Brother Knights and Families,


We had a great first fish fry, some people even told us that we have the **Best Fish Fry** (**BFF**) in Town. One of those people was our State District Deputy John Franssen who was a former Grand Knight in our council. We started off a little slow but then it picked up and was steady all night. We ended up with a great crowd of people enjoying the fish and comradery with family, friends and parishioners, we even had our three priests in attendance. After tallying the numbers for both inside dine-in and take out along with outside drive thru, we served 427 adults, 67 kids and had 26 comped meals for a total of 520 meals. We took in \$6,902.00 but have not taken out the expenses yet so we will not know how much the profit we made until all the expenses are entered.

As I was surveying the parking lot, I noticed a young mom and her two kids crossing South Street to get to our building. I do not know if they live in the area or just had to park in the neighborhood to find a parking spot. Later, I noticed the same lady and her two kids trying to handle their takeout containers and get stuff from our serving table. I asked her if she could use a bag or two and she said yes. Then as I was out in the fish fry tent at the outside door, I noticed the three of them, re-crossing the street and thought to myself, must be some damn good fish to go through all that trouble. It just goes to show what these events mean to people and why we enjoy doing them. I hope everyone's experience is one that enhances their Lenten season and brings some happiness to the end of their week.

It takes a lot of planning, ordering, organizing, prepping, setup, serving, and cleanup to put these on but it is all becomes worth it when you see all the happy faces of the people who wait all year for our fish fries. The Fitzgerald Hall phone doesn't stop ringing with people asking, "Are you having your fish fries?" So, if you were not able to join us this week, we have 5 more before they are gone for another year. We serve baked cod and fried pollack along with some great coleslaw and your choice of potatoes. I especially would like to thank all the kids that helped us serve our customers by pouring drinks, clearing tables or running fish and fries, it's always a welcome site. This week we had the Boy Scouts from Troop 28 help run the food in the drive through so we thank them for their service.



KOC District and Regional Free Throw Contest


The Knights of Columbus District and Regional Free Throw Competition was held at the Pius High School gym on March 8th.




